Airport to Michigan State University (MSU)

We recommend flying to Lansing.

- Take a taxi to the MSU Campus from the Lansing Capital City Airport. Cost is about \$30.00 + \$6.00 tip.
- From Detroit, a bus service is available. Take the Michigan Flyer www.michiganflyer.com from Detroit Metro Airport to East Lansing. The bus will drop you off at the Marriott Hotel East Lansing. Take a taxi from there to your residence hall.
